Day-by-day Itinerary

Day 1

- Pick-up at Zagreb Airport and stop at the House of Magical Herbs in Paka
- Scenic drive to northern Croatia and arrival in Čakovec / Međimurje County
- Guided walking tour of the town with a local guide, followed by a welcome dinner featuring biodynamic food from local producers

Day 2

- Arriving in Donji Kraljevec, the birthplace of Rudolf Steiner
- Visit the Rudolf Steiner Center for a guided tour and lecture, including a visit of the house in wich Rudolf Steiner was born back in 1861
- Afternoon tour through Lower Međimurje: Kotoriba: traditional basket weaving demonstration Vidovec: gold panning experience

- Lovrec winery story and wine tasting in Sveti Urban before going back to the hotel

Day 3

- Morning visit to the Mura–Drava Regional Park, a cross-border UNESCO biosphere reserve
- Stop at Peklenica, the site of the first oil field in this part of Europe
- Continue with a visit to Eco Holiday Home Lina
- Dvanajščak Kozol winery, biodynamic wines, guided tasting, and vineyard tour

Day 4

- After breakfast, check out and drive to the Maribor region / Slovenia
- Visit Vogrinčič Beekeeping experience traditional beekeeping and the healing power of bees, with honey tasting
- Arrival in Ljubljana, the Capital of Slovenia, city tour, dinner, overnight

Day 5

- Morning visit to the Waldorf School in Ljubljana, the first and oldest Waldorf school in Slovenia, where guests will be introduced to the principles of Steiner's pedagogy through a guided tour and meeting with educators.
- Afterwards, a scenic excursion to Lake Bled, one of Slovenia's most iconic destinations, surrounded by the Julian Alps, the emerald-green lake, the island church, and the medieval castle, creates an unforgettable alpine atmosphere
- Optional *pletna* boat ride and lakeside lunch

Day 6

- Leaving Ljubljana after breakfast, arrival at Postojna Cave, one of the largest and most impressive karst cave systems in the world guided tour through its magnificent chambers, underground halls, and natural rock formations.
- In the afternoon, transfer to the Guerrilla Wines estate in the sunlit hills of the Vipava Valley. Discover their commitment to biodynamic principles, guided wine tasting, and exploring the surrounding vineyards with breathtaking views.
- Drive on to Croatia, arriving at Novigrad, a charming little coastal town, accommodation

Day 7

- Visit Chiavalon Olive Oil Estate in Vodnjan, where guests will enjoy a guided tasting of award-winning extra virgin olive oils at the family-run mill.
- Continue to Pula for a short visit to the spectacular Roman Arena, one of the best-preserved amphitheaters in the world. Lunch and free time in Pula.
- The day concludes with a visit to Kozlović Winery, widely regarded as one of the most beautiful wineries in Istria, known for its ecological approach to viticulture and elegant wines.

Day 8

• Transfer day from Istria to Zagreb, the Capital of Croatia, walking tour and free time to explore the city on your own

Day 9

- Visit to Černelič Biodynamic Farm, the farm is Demeter-certified and internationally awarded for its sustainable land stewardship.
- An optional visit to Zrno Organic Farm, the oldest certified organic farm in Croatia, located near Zagreb.
